**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law. The reported violation was discussed with you on May 3, 2011. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had stored and offered for sale Moravian style chicken pies, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated May 3, 2011 you admitted receiving the afore mentioned chicken pies from a Ms. Lori Stewart for the sole purpose of resale to the general public at Greene's Trading Post.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or uninspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or uninspected poultry, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
