NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law. The reported violation was discussed with you on May 11, 2011. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had transported, stored and offered for sale Moravian style chicken pies, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling to the general public, at Greene's Trading Post, Lenoir, NC. In a signed statement dated May 11, 2011 you admitted purchasing the Moravian style chicken pies from a local church and in turn offered them for sale to the general public at Greene's Trading Post.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or uninspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or uninspected poultry, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
