**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on June 13, 2012. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had stored, offered for sale and/or sold 14 quart size plastic containers, weighing approximately 28 pounds, of Pork Barbecue which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated June 13, 2012 you stated you were only storing the pork barbecue for a Mr. Tape Fleming but could not provide any contact information, address, etc. for Mr. Tape Fleming. You also stated that you knew that Mr. Tape Fleming did not operate under any State, Federal or County inspection program.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
