NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law and the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on October 12, 2013. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold cooked pork tamales, beef egg rolls and cooked chicken tamales, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated October 12, 2013 you stated you processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and sold misbranded meat products and poultry products without the benefit of county, state or federal inspection every Friday for the past four (4) years.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and the sale of misbranded/non-inspected poultry product is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23, and in violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and/or poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
