

NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law and the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violations were discussed with you on December 17, 2011. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had transported, stored, offered for sale and/or sold packages of beef roast, beef steaks, assorted pork chops, pork roast and various turkey, ham and bologna deli meats, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection, to the general public at the 321 Flea Market, Hudson, NC. In a signed statement dated December 17, 2011 you admitted purchasing the above mentioned meat and/or poultry products from several retail stores in the area and/or an individual whom you alleged you did not know.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties and that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to these violations. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry and/or meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
