**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on January 14, 2012. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale and sold, beef meat and cooked pork meat (wrapped in banana leaves), which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling. In a signed statement dated January 14, 2012 you stated that you purchased the misbranded/non-inspected cooked pork meat wrapped in banana leaves from a lady that you go to church with known as "Lo". You also stated that you purchased the beef meat from a company in Atlanta, Georgia and in turn repackaged the beef meat into retail size packages inside your store.

Please be advised that the receiving, processing, storing and/or offering for sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to process, store, offer for sale and/or sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
