**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on March 26, 2012. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold approximately twenty (20) pounds of cooked Pork Skins, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. You stated in a signed statement dated March 26, 2012 that you purchased a box of cooked Pork Skins from Two Brothers Pork Skins, Kannapolis, NC and in turn removed the cooked pork skins from the box (which contained the USDA mark of inspection and required labeling) and placed them in a large plastic storage type container where they were sold to your customers per their request.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
