NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on January 17, 2012. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had received, processed, stored and/or offered for sale, a whole swine carcass, weighing approximately 100 pounds, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling. You stated that you purchased the misbranded/non-inspected swine carcass from a Mr. Tony Spears, 1334 McLean Chapel Church Road, Bunnlevel, NC on or about December 20, 2011 and the swine carcass was delivered to your restaurant in the back of a pickup truck.

Please be advised that the receiving, processing, storing and/or offering for sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to receive, store, process and/or sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
