**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law. These violations were discussed with you on August 14, 2015. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, transported, stored, offered for sale and/or sold chicken pot pies which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to Let It Grow, 4825 Country Club Road, Winston Salem, North Carolina for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. In a signed statement dated August 14, 2015, you stated that you sold the above mentioned poultry products to Let It Grow since June, 2015.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to these violations. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
