

# **N.C. STATE UNIVERSITY PESTICIDE SCHOOLS**

*Follow these steps to become certified and licensed:*

1) **Understand what type of pesticide license you need.** The North Carolina Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (NCDA&CS) issues pesticide licenses in the state. Look at the list of categories to determine the one(s) you need here:

2) **Order manuals from the N.C. State University Pesticide Safety Education Program.** All questions on the Pesticide Exams come from manuals available at N.C. State University. Each manual corresponds to a particular licensing category. You can order manuals online at [www.pesticidemanuals.com](http://www.pesticidemanuals.com) or you can print the manual order form and mail it to N.C. State University with a check or money order by going here: **[pesticidesafety.ces.ncsu.edu/pesticide-manual-order-form/](http://pesticidesafety.ces.ncsu.edu/pesticide-manual-order-form/)**

3) **Sign up for a Pesticide School or an Exam Only option.\*** (*See Important Note Below*) NC State University offers Pesticide Schools which you can sign up for at **[www.pesticidemanuals.com](http://www.pesticidemanuals.com)**. At these schools we review the Core Manual, which is a book most people must take a test on, and we review certain subcategories. The NCDA&CS will allow you to register for and take the pesticide exams at the end of the school.

If you opt to take the exams given by the NCDA&CS without the school, look at test dates, exam fees, and register for the exam only option here: **[ncagr.gov/SPCAP/pesticides/exam.htm](http://ncagr.gov/SPCAP/pesticides/exam.htm)**

4) **Take your pesticide exams.** You can attend a Pesticide School and take the exam on the second day of the school, or you can opt to register for and take the exams apart from the pesticide schools.

## **\*Important Note About Fees:**

**Pesticide School:** \$25 (Private/Farmers) or \$45 (Commercial/Public Operators) Paid to N.C. State University.

**Exam Fees:** Paid to N.C. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
