Benefits of Proposed Revisions

- Increased flexibility in how the Commission allocates the limited resources for CCAP
- Improved program efficiency
- Ability for districts to receive more funding to help with larger CCAP projects
- Increased water quality benefits
- Statewide promotion of installed CCAP practices



How will the Commission allocate funding?

- Commission will allocate funding into three categories:
 - Cost share payments
 - Technical and administrative assistance
 - Education and outreach purposes
- Commission will allocate funds in three allocation pools:
 - District
 - State
 - Regional
- Allocations will be set in the Detailed Implementation Plan and based on the recommendations of the division and the needs expressed by districts (Strategy Plan responses).



Timeline

- CCAP rule revisions available for public comment: July & August
- Commission approves rule at September 21st meeting
- Rules Review Commission reviews SWCC approved rule: Fall/Winter 2016
- New rule effective when Rules Review Commission issues approval
- Detailed Implementation Plan approval: September/November 2016
- Allocations for FY2017 likely in January - March 2017*

**If timeline goes as scheduled*



What might the FY2017 CCAP allocation look like?

- Continued support of district employees funded by CCAP technical assistance
- Competitive regional application process for larger BMPs (~\$12,000 cap)
- Applications reviewed by CCAP Advisory Committee using a priority ranking form, forwarding recommendations to the Commission
- Commission approves applications and awards allocation of funds for those projects
