

# How to Downgrade from IE9 to IE8 for Windows 7


IBeam is not compatible with IE9 here is how to **downgrade from IE9 to IE8**.

On Installing IE9 your Internet Explorer 8 version will be upgraded to IE9 and IE9 will be installed as an update rather than as program hence it will not appear in programs list under Programs and Features.

So we need to remove IE9 update .

## Downgrading from IE9 to IE8

1. Close all programs, click Start and click Control Panel.
2. Click “Uninstall a Program” under Programs category.
3. Click “View installed updates” option in the task pane.
4. Now select *Windows Internet Explorer 9* shown under Microsoft Windows updates and click Uninstall and follow the instructions on the screen.



IE9 uninstall process lasts for minimum 3 minutes and you will be able to access Internet Explorer 8 as usual after you restart your computer.
