This workshop is funded by a Non-Point Source Pollution Control Grant, awarded by the NC DENR Division of Water Quality to a partnership of NCDA&CS Division of Soil and Water Conservation, the North Carolina Horse Council (NCHC), Sustainable Stables, LLC, and Soil and Water Conservation Districts in the Fall Lake Watershed. The three year grant provides financial and technical assistance to “equine operations” (horse farms) in the Falls Lake watershed for implementing BMPs that protect water quality.
