Subjects range from environmental science and stewardship to human populations and land use issues.



What is It's Our Water? (IOW)

- A North Carolina-specific high school Earth/Environmental Science curriculum and resources guide for North Carolina students and teachers.
- Covers the importance of water quality and quantity, monitoring and maintaining water quality, and the impacts individual choices and actions have on water quality.
- Centers around field activities in a local stream that lead to a final report and recommendations by the class.
- Activities are coordinated with a series of videos, demonstrations, classroom activities, homework and quizzes.
- Aligned with the North Carolina Standard Course of Study for high school Earth/Environmental Science.

Participants receive WET Guide, IOW Guide, the Healthy Water Healthy People Testing Kit, Manual, and the IOW DVD.
