[RUSLE 2 Training - Monday August 13th](#)

RUSLE 2 will need to be loaded on your laptop prior to the workshop.

[Irrigation Design Introductory Class -Tuesday August 14th](#)

Emphasis will be on micro irrigation, NRCS Standards, principals and concepts.

[Conservation Planning and Pond Site Assessments – Wednesday August 15th](#)

Morning session will be in-field training - be *prepared* to be in the field.

Please make arrangements to carpool when you can. There will be vans available for approximately 60 +/- attendees. If you are willing to transport others from the hotel please let me know and I will make sure you have all needed directions and location of where we will be loading.

A decision will be made to cancel the field training on Tuesday night *in case of inclement weather*. This will be announced during the meeting Tuesday night and will be sent on list serve. "Rain out" provisions have been made, so the training *will go on* at the hotel; just not in the field.

Clipboards will be available for your use but you need to make sure you have a pen/pencil for taking notes in the field.

Please bring with you the tool that your field office uses to measure slope on a field.

Laptops are not required for the google earth demonstration. However the enterprise client is an application that has NC specific data that can be used in planning activities. Completing an Ag Water Needs Assessment – Thursday August 16th

Completion of this session will meet requirements for SWCC Job Approval Authority for Water Needs Assessment.

The tool is attached and can be saved to your computer. When saving the AGWRAP.dat file rename it to AGWRAP.chm (our email system will not allow e-mailing of "chm" files). This is the help file to be put in the same directory as the spreadsheet model.

If anyone has trouble loading this file on your computer, myself as well as other Technical Services staff will be available throughout the week to make sure it is installed prior to Thursday morning.
