



Guidelines for selling eggs at the Piedmont Triad Farmers Market

- All eggs must be produced by the seller
- Must label all eggs as ungraded
- Must store all eggs at 45 degrees or less but not frozen and have a thermometer in your display case.
- Eggs must be transported and displayed under active refrigeration.
- Must provide an invoice or receipt with the growers name, address, telephone # and date of sale with each transaction. The invoice must also include the name of the purchaser and the quantity purchased. A copy of the invoice must be kept at least 30 days
- Sales of 30 doz. or more per week are subject to the North Carolina Egg Promotion Tax
