## Food Safety Forum to be held Aug. 10

Keynote speakers include Dr. James Gorny, senior advisor, Office of Food Safety for the Food and Drug Administration; Dr. Dan Engeljohn, deputy assistant administrator, Office of Policy and Program Development with USDA; and Dr. Robert Tauxe, deputy director, Division of Foodborne, Waterborne and Environmental Disease with the Centers for Disease Control.

The program runs from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and lunch will be served. The forum is free and open to the public, but attendees are asked to register. ## NCDA&CS offers advice on plasticulture production

The N.C. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services' Agronomic Division is holding a workshop Aug. 17 to help growers interested in plasticulture production learn more about this technology. The free workshop will be at ERW Farms in Bailey, and organizers ask attendees to register.

Plasticulture, which involves growing crops on plastic with drip irrigation, is a relatively recent practice in North Carolina, starting in the early 1980s on a limited basis.

"It has been primarily used to produce strawberries and a few specific vegetable crops," said Agriculture Commissioner Steve Troxler. "Today, many small family farms are experimenting with a much wider range of crops in an effort to maintain profitability and sustainability."

Plasticulture is radically different from traditional farming. It uses plastic materials,

such as film mulches and drip irrigation tape, to moderate the crop production environment. This technology helps crops withstand extreme fluctuations in weather, especially temperature and rainfall. It can also improve produce quality and yield, extend the growing season and optimize use of land and water resources.

Workshop attendees will learn how to avoid common and expensive pitfalls such as underwatering or applying the wrong balance of nutrients. The workshop will focus on fumigation regulations, weed control and disease management. Certified Crop Advisor credits and pesticide recertification credits will be available in connection with this training. To register, contact Kent Messick at (919) 733-2655.

The goal of the training is to provide growers and other agricultural professionals with the management skills necessary to

transition smoothly from traditional field crop production, said Messick, NCDA&CS Field Services Section chief.

"Plasticulture is receiving wide support largely because it is seen to be both environmentally sustainable and economically profitable," Messick said. "It is a promising choice for growers who are downsizing their operations and trying to earn more profit on fewer acres."

This is the second workshop being offered on plasticulture production. The first emphasized water management, fertilization and plant tissue sampling. Growers can contact their regional agronomist to ask questions about these handouts or to schedule a site visit. Both workshops are funded by a grant from the N.C. Tobacco Trust Fund Commission.

## NCDA&CS recommends buying bees from permitted dealers

Bees are essential to food production by aiding in the pollination of crops, but in recent years, the numbers of these agricultural helpers have declined because of disease and pests. To help ensure a healthy bee population in the state, the N.C. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services recommends beekeepers buy bees only from dealers permitted to sell in the state.

"By purchasing from permitted sellers, beekeepers protect our bee and honey industry and avoid buying diseased or Africanized bees or potentially transporting other harmful pests," said Don Hopkins, state apiarist with NCDA&CS. "Permitted sellers, either from North Carolina or another state, must have a current inspection certifying the health of the bees. In addition, production cannot be located in an area with Africanized bees."

A list of permitted sellers is maintained by NCDA&CS. To obtain a permit, sellers must submit an application, have a current inspection, sign a compliance agreement and pay a \$25 fee.

Beekeepers selling fewer than 10 bee hives in a calendar year or holding a one-time, going out-of-business sale for fewer than 50 bee

## From the tractor

Ambassador Ron Kirk, President Obama's U.S. trade representative, recently paid a visit to North Carolina to tout the pending free trade agreement with South Korea. If enacted, the agreement could be a boon to North Carolina farmers by expanding a potentially lucrative export market.

I support the Korean trade agreement because of the potential for this trade agreement to help North Carolina farmers. The president has instructed Kirk to complete the agreement by November.

It was an honor to play host to Ambassador Kirk and

members of his staff at two stops in Cabarrus County. First, we visited Tommy and Vicky Porter's poultry and livestock farm in Concord.

After that visit, we met with a group of farmers at a restaurant in Mount Pleasant. The farmers, representing producers of tobacco, row crops, sweet potatoes and livestock, quizzed Kirk about trade issues. Above all, they asked that Kirk's office work to have fair trade with other countries.

As readers may remember from one of my previous columns, North Carolina's agricultural exports topped \$3 billion for the first time in 2008, representing a significant boost to the state's

agriculture and agribusiness industry. Fair trade is critical to our producers' success now and in the future.

I am hopeful that we will see our export numbers continue to climb as a result of some recent trade missions.

Besides the Korean trade agreement, other topics discussed in the farmers meeting with Kirk included Canada's recent banning of 5,000 flavorings in tobacco products.

The latter issue is of major concern to growers of burley tobacco. Burley tobacco loses sugar during the curing process, leaving it with a bitter flavor.

Flavoring added in marketing counters the bitterness. Canada's

actions set a precedent that could affect exports of burley. As much as 80 percent of the U.S. burley crop is exported.

Kirk said he would monitor the burley issue and would intervene in cases of discrimination against the U.S.

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## N.C. Gov. Bev Perdue harvests the first "executive honey"

Gov. Bev Perdue recently suited up in beekeeper attire and approached a job perhaps no other North Carolina governor has tackled – pulling honeycombs from beehives with thousands of honey bees buzzing nearby.

The governor assisted Danny Jaynes, president of the North Carolina Bee-keepers Association and his wife, Mary Jaynes, in removing the honeycombs from the hives.

"That's a lot of honey," Perdue said, removing a narrow honeycomb literally dripping with sweet golden goodness.

The two beehives sitting on the north lawn of the executive mansion in Raleigh were installed late last year, after

grounds supervisor Gerald Adams decided to explore the benefits of adding bees to pollinate the gardens on the grounds.

Adams, who oversees production of a number of crops used by the first family and donated to local food banks, has already seen a dramatic difference.

"Apple trees that have never had more than a handful of apples on them now show 50 or 60 or more," Adams said. "The pollination benefits of the bees have been clear already within the first six months of having the hives."

"The honeybee is not only North Carolina's state insect, but also a crucial player in North Carolina agriculture. Their role in

pollinating our crops is essential, and often overlooked by people who don't know the important part they play," Perdue said. "Having the bees here on the mansion grounds not only gives us a chance to boost our own fruit

and vegetable production, but also serves as an educational tool for the school groups and tours who visit the mansion regularly."

So just how much honey did the group harvest? According to the Jaynes, nearly 12 gallons, or

some 150 pounds. The honey, which was inspected and deemed "Grade A," will be bottled and used at the mansion, given as gifts from the governor and first gentleman, and donated to local food banks.

hives are not required to have a permit. However, anyone may request an apiary inspection by contacting a regional inspector.

Information and applications for the Permit to Sell Bees in North Carolina are available by contacting Don Hopkins, NCDA&CS, 1060 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699, by calling (919) 233-8214, or online at [www.ncagr.gov/plantindustry/plant/apiary/sellbees.htm](http://www.ncagr.gov/plantindustry/plant/apiary/sellbees.htm). Information also is available at your local county extension office.

"Although bees are inspected for pests and diseases, no other ratings of quality or colony strength are made when a dealer is placed on the list," Hopkins said. "Inclusion of a seller on the list is not an endorsement of one dealer over another." New beekeepers are encouraged to work with a local beekeeping association and seek referrals from fellow beekeepers.

## State Fair's Early Bird Special offers extra incentives through Sept. 29

Fairgoers can buy discounted admission and ride tickets online in advance of the 2010 N.C. State Fair to save money on North Carolina's premier fall event. Admission, ride and concert tickets go on sale Monday, Aug. 2, at the State Fair website, [www.ncstatefair.org](http://www.ncstatefair.org).

"Gate admission prices increased this year by \$1, so buying in advance will help families save money," said State Fair Manager Wesley Wyatt. "Plus, early birds can earn free tickets for purchases made before Sept. 29 through the Early Bird Special promotion."

Admission tickets at the gate are now \$8 for adults and \$3 for children. Buying advance tickets will save \$2 per adult admission ticket and \$1 per child's ticket. Adult admission tickets for groups of 40 or more will cost \$5. An 18-ticket ride sheet will cost \$10 in advance, saving fairgoers \$8 off the price of ride tickets at the Fair. Children under age 6 and adults 65 and over get in free.

With the Early Bird Special, ticket buyers can earn up to three free adult admission tickets based on the total purchase amount before convenience fees. Spending between \$40 and \$100 earns one free ticket. Purchases of \$100.01 to \$200 will earn fairgoers two free tickets, and purchases of more than \$200 earn three free tickets.

Admission, ride, grandstand and Dorton Arena concert tickets apply toward the purchase total. The Early Bird Special lasts until Sept. 29, and is good for online sales only. Purchases cannot be combined.

"The N.C. State Fair remains a great value, and our advance sales program keeps this North Carolina tradition a very affordable family outing," Wyatt said.

## Organic certification grants still available

Organic growers in North Carolina can still apply for partial reimbursement of the cost of becoming certified or recertified producers through a program offered by the N.C. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.

"We still have about a third of the grant funds available, so I would encourage organic producers who have gone through the certification process to submit their application for reimbursement," said Kevin Hardison, marketing specialist with the N.C. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. "The deadline to apply

is Sept. 30."

Growers who are certified or recertified before Sept. 30, can apply for assistance. The program will pay 75 percent of the cost of certification, up to \$750.

The program is funded through a \$30,000 grant from the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Funds are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

To apply, growers must fill out an authorization form that can be found online at [www.ncdaorganic.org](http://www.ncdaorganic.org).

The completed form, a copy of the farm's certification and a copy of the receipts from the certifying agency should be mailed to

the NCDA&CS Division of Marketing, Attn. Kevin Hardison, 1020 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-1020. The invoice must show the total cost of certification and the 75 percent portion that is eligible for reimbursement.

Growers with questions can call Hardison at (919) 733-7887.

"As consumer interest in certified products has grown, so has the number of organic producers statewide," Hardison said. "North Carolina has more than 6,000 certified organic acres, and these farms produce a variety of vegetables, livestock, herbs and other products."
