## Got to Be NC Festival wraps up successful run

The Got to Be NC Festival posted its best attendance with more than 85,000 people attending the three-day event at the State Fairgrounds.

Attendees enjoyed a variety of North Carolina agricultural products, antique farm equipment, carnival rides and live music.

The event also featured the N.C. Food and Wine Expo, pig races, a draft horse pull, classic car show, Harley-Davidson motorcycle ride-in, tractor pull and lawnmower racing.

“We are overwhelmed by the area’s support of the festival and of North Carolina agriculture,” said Jim Knight, festival manager.

“Planning is already under way to make next year’s event even better, and we will announce those dates soon.”

held during the free three-day event, including the Carolina Pig Jig, bluegrass competition

and antique tractor showcase. More than 3,000 people sampled all-you-can-eat barbecue

## Equine owners should vaccinate against WNV, EEE

Equine owners are reminded that now is the best time to vaccinate horses, donkeys and mules against West Nile Virus and Eastern Equine Encephalomyelitis.

State Veterinarian David Marshall said these diseases are now endemic in North Carolina, but they are easily preventable.

“We haven’t had a lot of cases of EEE or West Nile the past few years, but the disease cycle ebbs and flows in our state,” Marshall said. “Horse owners should keep up their guard and continue to vaccinate against these diseases, as well as take other

precautions to minimize standing water that would allow mosquitoes to breed.”

In 2009, North Carolina had 23 reported cases of EEE in horses, 21 of which were fatal. It is estimated that for every reported case, three or four cases go unreported. In 2008, there were 13 reported cases.

Not only were there more cases in 2009, but cases were reported later in the year and farther west than in previous years. There were no reported cases of WNV in equine the past two years.

Horse owners should talk to their

veterinarians to determine the best time to start the vaccination process. Both vaccinations initially require two shots, 30 days apart, for horses that have no prior vaccination history.

Neither vaccination fully protects the animal until several weeks after the second shot, so it is best to vaccinate as early in the mosquito season as possible. Marshall recommends a booster shot of each vaccine be given every six months in North Carolina because of the extended active mosquito

## From the tractor by Agriculture Commissioner Steve Troxler

On Aug. 10 the N.C. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services will host the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Commissioner’s Food Safety Forum in the Expo Building at the State Fairgrounds in Raleigh.

It is hard to believe this will be the sixth year we have held a food safety event, but the response through the years has been good and each year this event continues to grow.

Food safety remains a hot topic for consumers, producers, regulators, public health professionals and university researchers. It is certainly one of our top priorities in the NCDA&CS. Ultimately, this issue involves everyone and

could have a significant impact on the state’s \$70 billion agriculture and agribusiness industry.

This year our program will focus on the future of food safety. Our guest speakers will be national food safety experts, representatives of the state’s congressional delegation, industry leaders, state and federal regulators, public health officials, emergency management staff and university staff.

We are proud to have joining us as keynote speakers: Dr. James Gorny, senior advisor, Office of Food Safety for the Food and Drug Administration; Dr. Dan Engeljohn, deputy assistant administrator, Office of Policy and Program Development with

USDA; and Dr. Robert Tauxe, deputy director, Division of Foodborne, Waterborne and Environmental Disease with the Centers for Disease Control.

I know we will have an insightful program given the expertise of these speakers. We’ll hear about produce safety and Good Agricultural Practices, food safety in terms of animal production, and foodborne illness outbreak investigations.

In addition, there will be a panel discussion on integrated food systems in North Carolina and a presentation on effective food safety messages.

The program runs from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and lunch will be served. The forum is free and

## NCD&CS employee named to EPA advisory committee on agriculture

Archie Hart of the N.C. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services has been named to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Farm, Ranch and Rural Communities Committee. The appointment is for two years.

The independent committee advises EPA on a range of environmental issues important to agriculture and rural communities.

Hart directs the NCD&CS Office for Small Farm Policy, which provides services to small, limited-resource and minority farmers.

"Archie understands the challenges facing our small and limited-resource farmers, and his perspective will be important to the EPA as it develops policies affecting agriculture and rural communities," said Agriculture Commissioner Steve Troxler. "He is an excellent choice for

this committee."

Committee members were selected from a large pool of applicants. New members include representatives from academia, agriculture and allied industries, non-governmental organizations, and state, local and tribal governments.

Hart has worked for the NCD&CS since 1992. He is a graduate of N.C. A&T State University with a bachelor's degree in animal science and a master's degree in plant science. Before joining the NCD&CS, he worked nine years for N.C. Cooperative Extension in Wake County.

He has served on numerous boards and committees, including the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Small Farm Advisory Committee, N.C. Small Farm Commission and the Tobacco Farm Life Museum Board of Directors.

season.

Symptoms of WNV in horses can include loss of appetite and depression, fever, weakness or paralysis of hind limbs, convulsions, impaired vision or hyperexcitability.

Symptoms of EEE, include impaired vision, aimless wandering, head pressing,

circling, inability to swallow, irregular staggering gait, paralysis, convulsions and death.

People, horses and birds can become infected from a bite by a mosquito carrying the diseases, but there is no evidence that horses can transmit the virus to other horses, bird or people through direct contact.

## Ag Review advertisers, beware of scam

We recently heard from an Agricultural Review advertiser offering a cautionary tale for fellow advertisers. The advertiser said she was contacted by someone interested in buying an animal from her. The prospective customer then e-mailed her saying that payment was on its way and that she should cash the check immediately. The customer said the payment would contain "excess funds" that the seller should then send to a third party to cover transportation costs.

The prospective customer's e-mail was poorly written and contained numerous grammatical

and spelling errors. The poor quality of the e-mail made the advertiser wary, and she did not follow through with the sale.

This is similar to a scam that has been circulating for several years. The way it works is that a potential buyer sends the seller a fake cashier's check, made out for more than the agreed upon selling price. Then the "buyer" claims to have made a mistake and asks the seller to wire the difference back or write a check to refund the over-payment.

The seller deposits the check, the bank credits the account, and the seller assumes the check has

cleared. So the seller wires or mails the requested funds. But the "buyer's" check bounces, and the bank reduces the seller's account by the wired amount.

There are ways to spot these scams. They usually have multiple misspellings, poor grammar and often look like form letters. The "buyer" typically sends a check and pressures you to deposit it quickly so you can send a refund or forward a payment to a third party.

## Agrotips for July 2010

### Mulch to prevent blossom-end rot of tomatoes

If garden soils have adequate moisture and a pH in the range of 6.3 to 6.5, tomatoes are not likely to have blossom-end rot. Although this common problem is largely due to calcium deficiency, fertilization is not usually the answer. Any soil with a pH of 6.3 to 6.5 will contain enough calcium. However, during dry periods, plants cannot take up the calcium that is there. If your soil pH is good, you can optimize calcium availability by managing soil moisture. Make sure your plants get an inch of water each week, but be careful not to overwater. Apply 2 to 4 inches of mulch (pine bark, straw, leaf compost or other organic material) to help the soil retain moisture.

### Got nematodes?

Fields with spotty, irregular patches of stunted, wilted, yellowing or dead plants are likely to have an infestation of plant-parasitic nematodes. The degree of injury to the roots varies with the age of the plant when attacked, and symptoms are most severe when feeding occurs during the first few weeks after planting. The only way to positively diagnose a nematode problem is to submit soil samples with roots for nematode assay. For best results, submit matching samples from a "bad" area and a

nearby "good" area.

### Collect cotton tissue samples.

Collect tissue samples (MRMLs + detached petioles) weekly beginning at early growth (at least by matchhead square or one week before first bloom) and continuing for three to four weeks after first bloom.
