## Mountain State Fair offers family fun Sept. 7-16

The 2012 Mountain State Fair promises to live up to its theme of "Squeals, Thrills and Ferris Wheels" with plenty of fun activities, musical entertainment, rides, crafts, food and agricultural shows planned for the whole family.

The fair runs Sept. 7-16 at the Western N.C. Ag Center in Fletcher.

"Even more entertainment and activities are planned for this year's fair," said Agriculture Commissioner Steve Troxler. "You won't want to miss Western North Carolina's premier agricultural event."

The Mountain State Fair celebrates the traditions and heritage of mountain crafters and entertainers, featuring a clogging competition, a daily Mountain Music Festival and handmade items from local crafters.

Two additions to this year's lineup will bring extreme sports excitement to the fairgrounds. The Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association Rodeo will be held Monday, Sept. 10, through Thursday, Sept. 13, at 6 p.m. in the Stampede Corral.

The Haywood Community College Timber Sports Team will demonstrate lumberjack skills at 1:30, 4:30 and 7:30 p.m. Friday, Sept. 7, through Sunday, Sept. 9.

A number of fair favorites return to entertain visitors. Among the popular returning acts are the Kenya Safari Acrobats, the Hogway Speedway Racing Pigs, chainsaw artist Dan Smathers and Dixie Starlight Express, a choreographed precision equestrian team.

Fairgoers who are into music will find plenty to

entertain them with three stages dedicated to local and regional talent. The Bojangles Music Stage features a variety of acts performing a variety of musical styles.

Among the performers are Nikki Talley, Nuthin Fancy, Leigh Glass Band, Old North State, Kayla McKinney, Buddy K Big Band, Michelle Lee, Sharkadelics, Tom Fish, The

Vinyl Brothers Big Band and more. Bands perform throughout the day.

The Heritage Music Stage will feature bluegrass and traditional Appalachian music nightly at 7 p.m. The Pepsi Music Stage features daily performances by musician Leon Jacobs Jr.

The Mountain State Fair has a long history of hosting engaging and educational shows. Magician Brad Matchett brings agriculture to life in his entertaining Agricadabra Presents: The Science of Ag show where kids of all ages will learn about our state's leading industry.



## From the tractor

### Commissioner Troxler

Protecting farmland is one of my major priorities as Agriculture Commissioner. Not too many years ago, North Carolina led the country in the loss of farms – a distinction that I was not proud of.

But we were not alone in the loss of farms and farmland to development. Other states were experiencing sim-

ilar situations, which really signified a bigger crisis to me.

To me, I saw our rich, fertile farmland coming under attack, with little in the way of defenders. And the loss of farmland meant a loss also of future production opportunities since developed land rarely returns to its natural state.

One of the ways we have worked to slow the loss of farms and farmland in North Carolina is by providing grants through the Agricultural Development and Farmland Preservation Trust Fund. We have been extremely fortunate to receive funding from the N.C. General Assembly for the trust fund even in tough eco-

nomie times. I would love to see even more funding for ADFPTF grants because I think the needs are definitely there, but I am proud that we continue to chip away at this issue in North Carolina.

We recently awarded more than \$2 million to help communities across the state protect farmland and promote agricultural enterprises. It is estimated that these projects will have a total economic impact of \$11.6 million across 40 counties, with every region of the state represented.

A total of 20 projects received funding in the latest grant cycle. Among them were three agricultural plans, seven agricultural development projects and

10 perpetual conservation easements. In addition, funding was provided to counties looking to beef up their Voluntary Agricultural District programs.

More than 900 acres of farm and forest land will be protected through the conservation easements. In total, since 2005 when the trust fund started, more than 8,500 acres of working lands have been protected across the state.

We still have a lot of work to do, but we have tremendous support from our counties and conservation groups, which is encouraging.

Advance tickets are \$6 for adults and \$2 for kids 6 through 12 and seniors 65 and older. That is a savings of \$1 off each ticket. Ride coupons are \$6 for a book of 12 tickets, half the price if purchased during the fair. The fair is also offering the Family Fun Pack for \$30, which includes five admission tickets, tickets for four rides and discount coupons for fair vendors.

In addition, fairgoers can save money and help feed the hungry by attending Wednesday, Sept. 12, for Ingles Day at the Mountain State Fair. Fairgoers get free fair admission with five cans of Laura Lynn brand food from Ingles. Food collected is donated to the Manna Food Bank.

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## Preventing and managing food recalls will be the focus of September NCDA&CS workshop

The N.C. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and the N.C. Food Safety and Defense Task Force will host a workshop Sept. 19 in Raleigh on preventing and managing food recalls. The event is tailored for home-based food businesses, shared-use kitchens, food and meat processing facilities and co-packers.

"A food recall can be damaging for any food business, but particularly for new and smaller companies," said NCDA&CS food business specialist Annette Dunlap. "Fortunately, there are several steps food entrepreneurs can take to prevent a recall from happening and prepare for a recall if it does occur."

The workshop will feature presentations from retailers, health officials, food inspectors and NCDA&CS staff. Topics include the economics of a food recall, a retailer's perspective, communicating a recall to your customers and the public, common and avoidable mistakes in the food safety chain, seafood safety hazards, foodborne disease outbreak prevention and preventing intentional food contamination.

# Renewable energy options may benefit farm operations

As renewable energy becomes increasingly common throughout the state, opportunities for rural communities to take advantage of renewable energy are growing rapidly.

Energy costs impact the economic operation of agricultural enterprises. By identifying potential renewable energy opportunities, farms may reduce their energy consumption, lower the cost of operation, and improve the economic viability of the business.

The N.C. Solar Center is hosting a webinar titled "Renewable Energy for Ag-

riculture and Rural Small Businesses" Sept. 5 at 3 p.m. to share more about this technology. To reserve your spot, go to <https://www2.gotomeet-ing.com/register/209238706>.

The N.C. Solar Center also offers reduced-cost renewable energy assessments for rural small businesses and agricultural producers. The center can provide this assistance with minimal cost to the end user, generally \$450-\$550 depending on travel distance required.

The assessments focus on practical ways companies can incorporate renewable energy into their facilities

and existing energy systems. Potential renewable energy technologies are: solar energy, photovoltaics (PV), solar hot water, daylighting, transpired walls, biomass (e.g. wood, poultry litter, etc.), digester gas (e.g. swine waste, wastewater, etc.), combined heat and power, wind generation and micro-hydro.

The program is open to ag producers and rural small businesses. Private entities, including sole proprietorships, partnerships, corporations, co-ops, and electric utilities are eligible. Non-profit organizations and public entities are not eligible.

Agricultural producers must directly engage in production of agricultural products and at least 50 percent of gross income must be from the agriculture business.

The Solar Center's Renewable Energy Assessments focus on practical ways to incorporate renewable energy into facilities and existing energy systems. The assessment includes a single day trip to the project site to inspect the site and collect technical information needed for developing the feasibility study and making appropriate recommendations.

A report will be prepared

detailing the findings of the site assessment. The report will present an assessment of the potential for implementing Renewable Energy technologies, and will include an introduction to the technologies that are deemed to have potential for success at the facility. Each technology will be analyzed for its technical and economic feasibility.
