1. Kennels 13,22,23,29 and 25b wire needs to be repaired.
The wire in the above listed Kennels has been repaired as of 4-15-13.
2. Cat colony rooms – Sheetrock need to be repaired in both (covered).
The sheetrock will be repaired in both rooms by 4-19-13
3. All outside runs are still in need of gravel, this has now been noted in the last three inspections.
We are in the process of getting estimates on gravel, labor, etc. to be able to complete this task. Under our present cash flow problems we will gravel as many of the runs as possible in the next thirty (30) days. The ones that cannot be graveled at the present time and brought up to your specifications will be closed and not used until we can afford to gravel or concrete.
