Dear Lt. Skeen,

On or about September 30, 2009 you were sent a **Notice of Warning and Voluntary Suspension of Gas Chamber Operation Privilege** because your CO chamber did not have a yearly inspection as required under NCAC 52J .0601 et seq. You agreed to voluntarily suspend use of the CO chamber until an inspection report was sent to this office and you received noticed that you could resume use of the chamber.

The Animal Welfare Section received a copy of the required yearly inspection report dated 2 October 2009. A review of the report shows that your CO chamber was inspected in accordance with the NC Administrative Code.

This letter serves as notice that you have fulfilled the requirements set forth in the Warning Letter and that you may resume use of your CO chamber as long as it meets the requirements of the NC Administrative Code. A copy of this notice will be sent to you by both FAX and by US mail.
