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**Narrative Explanation**Follow-up inspection from 9/16/14Items corrected:

1. Facilities / Food Protected / Food Storage Room - All of the bags of dry food are found stored off the floor today. The exterior of the room has been caulked to aide in moisture control.
2. Sanitation / Pest Control / Food Storage Room - The room was clean of spider webs and spiders today.
3. Facilities / Sound Repair - All 3 of the metal doors from the office to the back of the shelter which were rusted have been replaced. All of these doors have windows in the upper half which aides in giving more light in the shelter.
4. Primary Enclosures / Impervious to Moisture - K-9 kennel room floors - all of the chain link kennels (14) were disassembled order for the floors to be refurbished. The painted concrete floors that were chipping and peeling were stripped down to the bare concrete. The Industry One / Clean Care Company installed an epoxy floor. Today all the kennels have been re-assembled with the cross contamination barriers sealed. The floor work looks very good - the surrounding cracks (outer walls) have been caulked as the epoxy could not be extended up the walls. The floors have enough grit not to be slick yet smooth enough to make cleaning easy. All the work looks very good and is acceptable.

New Items to Correct:

.0201 Facilities / Sound Repair & .0207 Sanitation / Isolation - Cat Room & K-9 Isolation (quarantine room) - It is noted today that there is a crack around the perimeter of both rooms between the floor and the walls. This crack needs to be caulked (sealed). In the K-9 isolation room there is a vertical crack between the main building wall and the south wall. It appears the old building has shifted. Seal this crack. It is imperative that the isolation room be well sealed to prevent the spread of any contagious disease or virus.

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Narrative Explanation

.0205 Feeding / Feeding Bowl in Good Repair - It is noted today the galvanized food pans are rusted. Replace the food pans with a pan that will not corrode (Stainless Steel was discussed).

.0204 Primary Enclosures / Solid Resting Surface - Today it was noted there were 3 runs with 2 dogs each that there needed to be a resting surface for each dog. They were large dogs and there was not enough space on the one krunda bed for 2 dogs. Decrease the amount of dogs per run so there is enough space for each dog to have a resting surface.

.0207 Sanitation / Pest Control - Food Storage Room - There was still rodent sign noted in the food storage room. Advised daily cleaning of this room and using rodent control plus make sure all opened boxes / bags of food are placed in a rodent proof container.

Comments:

Temperatures were in range in all areas.

There were no signs of untreated injury or illness noted.

The k-9 general population room smelled very clean today.

The room between the office and kennels has been painted.

A new heating system has been recently installed.

Follow - up inspection in 30 calendar days on all items - 12/10/14.
