

Narrative Explanation, if needed

At time of today's inspection (9:15am) records were available for all dogs on site. Plans to implement petpoint will help with organization of these records.

Improvements since previous inspection:

- 1) Enclosures have been re-located within the main yard so the animals do not have access to the wood on the secondary fence.
- 2) Shavings have been removed.
- 3) Weeds are under control.

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Narrative Explanation, continued

Inadequacies remaining from courtesy inspection:

- 1) Repair/Replace sharp edges of exposed wire as necessary on primary enclosures. Some sharp edges have been repaired yet many others still exist. (0201).
- 2) At time of inspection 1 dog house was supplied for all dogs. However, several remain in need of repair/ replacement. (0203).
- 3) Several holes still exist in many of the primary enclosures. Repair of former holes using crate doors is inadequate due to sharp edges. Repair holes in primary enclosures. (0201).
- 4) A sufficient amount of gravel was added to the play yard however bare dirt areas exist in primary enclosures. Gravel bare dirt areas with a minimum of 6" of gravel in primary enclosures (0203).

New inadequacies noted at time of inspection on October 15, 2012 include:

- 1) A large amount of feces was present indicating that waste is not removed twice daily. Remove waste twice daily (0201,0207).
- 2) Taking into account the large amount of rainfall prior to inspection, drainage remains an issue and should be directed away from primary enclosures and the play area. Tarps over primary enclosures should be constructed in a manner to prevent drainage into primary enclosure.
- 3) Bowls and food in primary enclosures were soaked. Protect bowls/food from drainage. (0201,0205).
- 4) Several bags of trash were noted around the enclosure area. Remove waste daily. (0201).
- 5) Flies are an issue developing from wet food throughout facility. Some wet food was noted over the perimeter fencing. Implement pest control. (0207).

Will re-inspect in 30 days for licensing.
