Narrative Explanation, continued

Inadequacies noted at 3-26-15 inspection:

*0201(a) - Housing in sound repair is not acceptable today due to the seal strips on the ceiling in the back kennel area are peeling from the ceiling and hanging, exposing the ceiling board joints. Also viewed wooden door jams located outside that have been chewed and scratched - replace these jams with a product impervious to moisture.

*0201(d)-Viewed 5 bags of open food, not stored in airtight or sealed containers. These bags of food were stored in cubbies, and open so that air, debris, and insects could easily get inside. All open food is to be stored in airtight containers (aka: lidded storage bins, ziploc bags, etc).

*0204(a)-Primary Enclosures deemed not acceptable for cross contamination barriers, and being impervious to moisture in the following areas: 1.) Cross Contamination barriers need to be added between enclosures 38, 39, 40, 41, 32, 31, 30, 29, and the back kennel area. It is noted that some enclosures have metal 3ft barriers, and some only have a 3 inch water barrier at the bottom of the cages - all enclosures need solid contamination barriers. 2.) Chipped paint/Epoxy noticed in enclosure #41 - reseal this enclosure. 3.) Wooden slab was noted in enclosure #22 - remove this wood - no animals may have access to wood of any kind within their enclosures.

*0207(b6) (c) - Sanitation is deemed not acceptable today due to areas accessible to animals were found to have a build up of hair and cobwebs. A deep cleaning is needed throughout this facility. Also noted brushes, accessories, and large amounts of washed down hair behind the outside (side) kennels - Outside areas are to be kept clean. Reinspect in 30 days.
