Narrative Explanation, if needed

Euthanasia was performed by two staff members by use of CO on one cat. Cat was handled humanely throughout. Death was verified by both staff members by lack of ocular reflex and heartbeat. Euthanasia by injection was not performed during this inspection.

Weekly inspections on chamber are being done and were documented. The seals were replaced within the last week. (.0606) The last yearly inspection was performed in October 2013. I informed John that this needs to be performed as soon as possible.

The policy and procedure manual were missing the following documents: (.0803) list of current CET's (certificates were present for the staff members that are current but the list reflected employees that were no longer employed), contact information for the suppliers, and notice of signs and symptoms for humans exposed to euthanasia agents. This was corrected at the time of my inspection.



Re: Chamber Inspection 04 December 2014

CO readings, done with a calibrated MSA MinICO Meter, revealed no leaks in any of the seals, view ports, pipe fittings, or hoses. The chambers were found to be operating as designed, providing 8.8% CO to the chamber in 22 seconds at 20 psi. The CO level in the area around the chamber remained at the background level.

The exhaust fan is warranted by the manufacturer to be explosion proof.

At this time, these chambers are operating as designed, and are safe to operate.
