Narrative Explanation, continued

Purpose of my visit today is to perform a random inspection of the facility as well as update information on the facilities Veterinary Program after our department recieved a letter in April 2012 of the resignation of the Veterinarian that was working with the facilities program. Facility is now working with a new Veterinarian in the area; Dr. Scheilling of Academy Veterinary Servicesd.

Items noted during today's random inspection include:

0202} Concrete flooring in the indoor facility needs to be resealed making this area impervious to moisture.

0204} Concrete flooring and cinderblock walls within the primary enclosures need to be resealed. Adoption kennel # 12 has a hole in the chain link rear gate that needs to be repaired - in the meantime, do not use this kennel and place a sign on the kennel stating that it is out of use until repairs have been made. Primary enclosures/cages that are housing more than 3 at a time, needs to have an elevated surfaces within each enclosure (discussed options with ACO).

It is noted that the shelter's total number of animals on-site during my inspection was quite high (mainly large litters); however every animal had adequate enclosure and space - it was discussed that the shelter should not intake many more animals until some are moved out to keep the facility from being over-crowded and therefore would make the facility more subceptable to disease, as well as sanitary issues.

There were no vehicles available for inspection today, ambient temperature was 75 degrees within holding areas, and cleaning was on-going at my time of visit. Also discussed the need for the facility to submit it's annual renewal paperwork, due on June 15, 2012; with instructions left for the new director on how to do so.
