Narrative ExplanationFollow-up inspection from 2/24/14.Item corrected:

.0101 Records / Origin & .0101 Disposition - Impound records were closely examined for the past month to determine if there was improvement in recording the origin and disposition of the animals - much improvement was noted. There were several records found that whether than animal was scanned or not was not marked. The shelter director and manager stated there were a few days when the scanners were not working but now are and they have 2 scanners on site now. Remember ALL animals' records must be marked to indicate they have been scanned.

Comments:Cleaning was ongoing during the inspection.Temperatures were in range in all areas of the shelter.There were no signs of untreated illness or injury noted.Item to correct:

.0207 Sanitation / Building - Feral cat room & Adoptable cat & small dog/puppy room - The banks of stainless steel cages in the small dog room that sit flat on the floor cannot be cleaned behind due to the weight of the cages. Today dust & dirt were found behind these cages. These cages need to be elevated off the floor by building a frame and inserting casters (wheels) so these cages can be moved to clean behind them. It is not the fault of the staff - they are not strong enough to move these heavy cages. More attention to cleaning is needed - dusting between the upper and lower stainless steel cages in both rooms.

Put wheels on banks of cages so they can be moved and clean behind, between & underneath cages.Follow-up inspection in 30 calendar days - 4/25/14.

A copy of Senate Bill 626 and the SB 626 memo has been left with the Shelter Director Alan Conroy.


