

NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law and the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violations were discussed with you on September 21, 2011. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had transported, processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold meatloaf dinner entrees, beef burritos, various chicken dinners and chicken fajitas, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection. In a signed statement dated September 21, 2011 you admitted selling the afore mentioned misbranded meat and poultry products to another vending company for approximately eight months and the general public for three years.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties and that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to these violations. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry and/or meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
