NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law and the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violations were discussed with you on May 9, 2011. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had transported, stored, offered for sale and/or sold one (1) whole chicken, three (3) packages of ground beef, two (2) packages of pork chops and three (3) packages of beef ribeye steak, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection. In a signed statement dated May 9, 2011 you admitted purchasing misbranded meat and poultry products from a supermarket in Galax, Virginia on four to five different occasions in the last three weeks for the sole purpose of resale to the general public at your store.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or uninspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties and that the sale of misbranded and/or uninspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to these violations. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or uninspected poultry and/or meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
