

**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violation was discussed with you on December 8<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you stored and/or offered for sale approximately 80 pounds (1 case) of ground beef patties which were adulterated (unfit for human consumption). In a signed statement dated December 13, 2010, you admitted to storing adulterated meat products.

Please be advised that the storing and/or offering for sale of adulterated meat products is a violation of the North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to store and/or offer for sale adulterated meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
