**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violations were discussed with you on February 3, 2011. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had stored, offered for sale and/or sold 11 packages of longaniza, 2 packages of seasoned beef and 2 packages of seasoned pork, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated February 3, 2011 you stated that you purchased the afore mentioned meat products from an unknown Hispanic man who stopped by your store.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or uninspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
