NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violation was discussed with you on January 28th, 2011. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you received, offered for sale and/or sold approximately 22 pieces of "Banh Bao" fully cooked pork dumplings, with no State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling to the general public. You admitted in a signed Shipper's or Receiver's Certification dated January 28, 2011 that you purchased the "Banh Bao" on two separate occasions from an unknown individual who stopped by your store.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or uninspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or uninspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
