**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Laws. This reported violation was discussed with you on February 3, 2014. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had stored, offered for sale and/or sold Chicken Dinner Balls, Chicken Breast Fillets, Chicken Nuggets and Chicken Wing-Zings, which did not contain State (N.C.D.A.) or Federal (U.S.D.A.) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated February 3, 2014 you stated you purchased large boxes of Chicken Dinner Balls, Chicken Breast Fillets, Chicken Nuggets and Chicken Wing-Zings from Pate Dawson Company in Goldsboro, N.C. and in turn removed the five pound bags, which did not contain marks of inspection or required labeling, from the master containers and sold them to the general public.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
