

**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law and the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. These reported violations were discussed with you on January 10, 2013. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had stored, offered for sale and/or sold pork feet, pig ears, pork sausage, liver pudding, red hots, pork spare ribs, soup bones and turkey wings, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated January 10, 2013 you stated you purchased the above mentioned meat and poultry products from Wilson Packing Co., Wilson, NC and in turn removed the afore mentioned products from the master containers and placed the products into clear small plastic bags. You then offered for sale and sold the meat and poultry products to the general public without the required marks of inspection or required labeling.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties and that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to these violations. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry and/or meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
