**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law and the North Carolina Poultry Products Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on June 21, 2014. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you processed, stored, transported, offered for sale, and sold fully cooked beef, pork and chicken egg rolls, which did not contain a State (N.C.D.A.) or Federal (U.S.D.A.) marks of inspection or required labeling. In a signed statement dated June 21, 2014 you stated that you offered for sale and sold the fully cooked beef, pork and poultry egg rolls at 311 Highway Flea Market, 7190 U.S. Hwy 311, Sophia, N.C. for the past nine (9) months without the benefit of State (N.C.D.A.) or Federal (U.S.D.A.) inspection to the general public.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat and poultry products is a violation of the North Carolina General Statutes (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 and §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat and poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
