

NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law. These reported violations were discussed with you on October 5th and 25th, 2012. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had transported, stored, offered for sale and/or sold "Banh Cun" (rice flour wraps containing cooked chicken), which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated October 25th, 2012 you stated you purchased the above mentioned poultry products from an Asian Market in Charlotte, NC on North Tryon Street and transported the poultry products back to your business and offered them for sale to the general public.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to these violations. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
