

NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on June 19, 2012. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold approximately eleven (11) pounds of link pork sausage which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In addition our investigation revealed that you stored, offered for sale and/or sold one pound cups of pork barbecue that did not contain the required retail labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated June 19, 2012 you stated you purchased the link pork sausage from a distributor and in turn cut and wrapped the link pork sausage per the customer's request.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
