NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on May 17, 2013. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and/or sold beef and turkey sandwich wraps, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling to a retail store (Hudson News, Terminal 2, Raleigh Durham Airport). In a signed statement you stated that you prepared the misbranded/non-inspected beef and turkey sandwich wraps in your restaurant.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat and poultry products are a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 and (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat and poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
