NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on January 17, 2014. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, transported, and offered for sale pork mandu dumplings, which did not contain State (N.C.D.A.) or Federal (U.S.D.A.) marks of inspection or required labeling, to LoMo Market, 218 Hood Street, Durham, N.C. for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. In a signed statement dated January 17, 2014, you stated that you had been selling the misbranded (no state or federal marks of inspection) pork mandu dumplings to Lo Mo Market, 218 Hood Street, Durham weekly for the past year.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
