NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law and the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violations were discussed with you on March 20, 2012. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold 35 packages of beef tripe, chicken drumsticks, cut up chickens and/or smoked turkey, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection, to a retail store for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. In addition, our investigation revealed that your firm failed to keep accurate and legible records of all sales to Hotels, Restaurants and Institutions (H.R.I.).

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties and that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to these violations. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry and/or meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
