NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on December 20, 2012. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, transported, stored, offered for sale and/or sold chicken salad and chicken and dumplings, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to A & L Mini Mart, 103 North Main St., Faith, NC for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. You stated in a signed statement dated December 20, 2012 that you had been selling the misbranded/non-inspected chicken salad and chicken and dumplings for approximately one year.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
