NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on August 17, 2012. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had received, stored, offered for sale and/or sold, four (4) goat carcasses, two (2) sheep carcasses and two (2) beef carcasses, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling and were adulterated with hair, ingesta, foreign material and/or fecal matter. You stated in a signed statement dated August 17, 2012 that you purchased the afore mentioned carcasses from High Point Halal Meats on August 16, 2012 for the sole purpose of processing and reselling to the general public.

Please be advised that the receiving, storing, offering for sale and/or selling of misbranded, non-inspected and/or adulterated meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded, non-inspected and/or adulterated meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
