

NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on February 7, 2013. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had stored, offered for sale and/or sold ten (10) packages of cooked pork rolls, weighing approximately ten (10) pounds, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. You stated in a signed statement dated February 7, 2013 that you purchased the misbranded/non-inspected cooked pork rolls from an unknown Vietnamese lady. You also stated that you did not have any contact information for the Vietnamese lady who sold you the misbranded/non-inspected cooked pork rolls.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
