**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on February 7, 2013. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had stored, offered for sale and/or sold cooked pork rolls wrapped in banana leaves (Gio Lua), which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated February 7, 2013 you stated you purchased the cooked pork rolls from a customer by the name of Ms. Lein Nguyn, Fayetteville, NC for the Chinese New Year. In addition you could not provide a receipt or invoice showing where you purchased the misbranded/non-inspected cooked pork rolls.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
