NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law and the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on April 30, 2014. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold cooked pork barbecue, fresh ground beef, and partially cooked breaded chicken breast, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated April 30, 2014 you stated you have processed, offered for sale and sold cooked barbecue, fresh ground beef, and partially cooked breaded chicken breast without benefit of state or federal inspection to Wysacky Restaurant, 7909 Lancaster Highway, Waxhaw, North Carolina 28173.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat and poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statutes (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 and §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat and/or poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
