

NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on August 28, 2012. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold thirty-one (31) packages of cutup pork meat, weighing approximately twenty-five (25) pounds, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. You stated in a signed statement dated August 28, 2012 that you purchased the cutup pork meat in bulk boxes from Han Feng, 6001 A West Market St., Greensboro, NC and in turn further processed the cutup pork meat into smaller consumer size packages without the benefit of required inspection.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
