**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on September 25, 2014. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and/or sold fully cooked Baked Spaghetti with Meat Sauce and Baked Ziti with Meat Sauce, which did not contain State (N.C.D.A.) or Federal (U.S.D.A.) marks of inspection or required labeling, to Patterson Farm, Inc., 10390 Caldwell Road, Mt. Ulla, North Carolina 28125 for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. In a signed statement dated September 25, 2014 you stated that you processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and sold Baked Spaghetti with Meat Sauce and Baked Ziti with Meat Sauce for approximately thirteen months.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
