NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violation was discussed with you on September 17, 2014. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you have slaughtered and/or processed beef and/or swine for the general public, without the benefit of NCDA (State) or USDA (Federal) inspection, at your facility located at 5209 Sugar and Wine Road, Monroe, North Carolina 28110.

Please be advised that the slaughter and/or processing of beef and/or swine for the general public, without the benefit of State or Federal inspection, is a violation of North Carolina General Statutes (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.17 & .23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regards to this violation. If you should continue to slaughter and/or process beef and/or swine for the general public, without benefit of State or Federal inspection, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
