NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law and the North Carolina Poultry Products Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on January 27, 2015. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold misbranded cooked chicken salad, beef chili, cooked chicken and pastry, and cooked chicken with rice which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, wholesale to two retail stores for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. In addition you sold the aforementioned products directly to the general public. In a signed statement dated January 27, 2015 you stated you have stored, offered for sale and sold cooked chicken salad, beef chili, cooked chicken and pastry, and cooked chicken with rice without benefit of state or federal inspection for approximately six (6) months to Nahunta Store and Tire, Nahunta N.C. and the Wayne Center Curb Market, Goldsboro, N.C. for the purpose of resale to the general public.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and the sale of misbranded/non-inspected poultry product is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23, and in violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and/or poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
