NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on October 4, 2014. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had provided an on farm location and/or facility for the slaughter and processing of lamb and goat carcasses, without the benefit of required State (N.C.D.A.) or Federal (U.S.D.A.) inspection. In a signed statement dated October 4, 2014 you stated that you sold live lambs and goats to the general public and allowed them to slaughter and process them on your property without the benefit of State (N.C.D.A.) or Federal (U.S.D.A.) Inspection.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
